P Napa then introduced today's guest speaker Benjamas Uamsa-Ard who will talk about New Generations.

Benjamas introduced the meeting guests to the youth committee of IPP Brian Andersen, P Napa Keawtem, Rtn Helmut Scepers and Ex Sec Martin Harrison.

Benjamas informed the meeting that New Generations refers to the youngest generation in the family of Rotary and that New Generations Service became Rotary's fifth Avenue of Service in 2010

- Interact (ages 12-18)
- Rotaract (18-30)
- Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)
- Rotary Youth Exchange.

Rtn Benjamas gave the meeting an overview of the Rotaract history and that around the world there were:

- 10,904 Rotaract clubs
- 250,792 Rotaractors
- 184 countries with Rotaract clubs

Our district 3330 her in Thailand has the most Rotaract clubs out of all the districts in Thailand with 32 Rotaract clubs.

Rtn Benjamas went on to say that Rotaract clubs bring together people ages 18-30 (membership will end upon reaching 31 years of age) to exchange ideas with leaders in the community, develop leadership and professional skills, and have fun through service.
